BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Section 7B: Healthcare-Associated Infections data is obtained directly from CDC's National Healthcare Safety Network (NHSN). Hospitals are required to join Leapfrog's NHSN Group, enter a valid NHSN ID in the Survey Profile, and submit the Survey to be scored and <u>publicly reported</u> on the following measures from Section 7: Managing Serious Errors:

- Central line-associated blood stream infections (CLABSI) in ICUs and select wards
- Catheter-associated urinary tract infections (CAUTI) in ICUs and select wards
- Facility-wide inpatient Methicillin-resistant Staphylococcus Aureus (MRSA) Blood Laboratory-identified Events
- Facility-wide inpatient Clostridium difficile (C.diff.) Laboratory-identified Events
- Surgical Site Infections from Colon Surgery (SSI: Colon)

In addition, Leapfrog obtains teaching status from the NHSN Patient Safety Component – Annual Hospital Survey.

Data will be available on the <u>Hospital Details Page</u> on July 12 and scored and <u>publicly reported</u> on July 25 for hospitals that:

- Join Leapfrog's NHSN Group and review/accept Leapfrog's Data Rights Template by June 22*
- Enter a valid NHSN ID in the Profile of the 2023 Leapfrog Hospital Survey, and
- Submit the 2023 Leapfrog Hospital Survey by June 30.

After July 25, Survey Results will be available on the Hospital Details Page and the public reporting website on the fifth business day of the month.

Hospitals that have completed the three steps above are also required to download and save their reports from NHSN on the **same day** as Leapfrog to verify the data downloaded, scored, and publicly reported by Leapfrog. More information may be found below.

* Hospitals are not required to "re-join" Leapfrog's NHSN Group if they joined and conferred rights in previous Leapfrog Hospital Survey Cycles. However, all hospitals in Leapfrog's NHSN Group must review their Rights Acceptance Report annually to ensure that Leapfrog has access to the data from all the locations that were active during the reporting period, even if those locations are no longer active, to ensure that Leapfrog obtains the appropriate SIR for each infection measure. Hospitals must review their Rights Acceptance Report by the first NHSN join-by date of each Survey Cycle.

IMPORTANT NOTES

JOINING THE NHSN GROUP AND REVIEWING/ACCEPTING THE DATA RIGHTS TEMPLATE

While hospitals who have previously joined Leapfrog's NHSN Group remain in the Group from year-to-year, Leapfrog requires all hospitals to review their Rights Acceptance Report annually, before the June 22, 2023, NHSN join-by date and whenever updates are made to their location mapping in NHSN.

Hospitals must include any locations that were active during the reporting period even if they are currently inactive to ensure that Leapfrog obtains an accurate SIR. Additionally, please confirm that you have given Leapfrog access to data from your 2022 NHSN Patient Safety Component – Annual Hospital Survey. Surveillance data

from the 2022 NHSN Annual Hospital Survey is used by NHSN to risk adjust SIRs; SIRs cannot be calculated by NHSN or downloaded by Leapfrog if you restrict access to this data.

Instructions on how to review, complete, and update the rights you confer in Leapfrog's Data Rights Template are below.

DOWNLOADING REPORTS FROM NHSN

Hospitals should follow the instructions provided <u>below</u> on how to regenerate datasets, save copies of the NHSN 2022 Patient Safety Component – Annual Hospital Survey, and download CMS IPPS Reports on the <u>same day</u> that Leapfrog will be downloading the data from NHSN for all current group members. These dates may be reviewed in the second column of the <u>Deadlines and Reporting Periods</u> table below.

Data entered in NHSN is not static and may be updated by hospitals at any time. Therefore, if your hospital makes any updates to either your HAI data (number of observed infections or number of device/patient days) or surveillance data (2022 NHSN Patient Safety Component- Annual Hospital Survey) after Leapfrog's NHSN data download dates, the CMS IPPS reports downloaded by your hospital *will not match* the reports downloaded by Leapfrog, even if they are for the same reporting period.

For this reason, Leapfrog urges all hospitals to regenerate datasets and download CMS IPPS reports and a copy of their 2022 NHSN Annual Hospital Survey from NHSN on the <u>same day</u> as Leapfrog to ensure that the HAI data downloaded by Leapfrog is accurate. Hospitals submitting a 2023 Leapfrog Hospital Survey by the Submission Deadline of June 30, 2023, should follow the instructions below to download reports from NHSN on June 23, 2023. This data will be available on your Hospital Details Page on July 12 and scored and <u>publicly reported</u> on July 25. After July 25, Survey Results will be available on the Hospital Details Page and the public reporting website on the fifth business day of the month.

The Leapfrog Hospital Survey closes on November 30, 2023. The last NHSN data download is on December 21, 2023, to incorporate any facilities and corrections from facilities that joined by the last join date of December 20, 2023.

Leapfrog will download data four times according to the dates and reporting periods listed in the table above for all current members of our NHSN group that have provided an accurate NHSN ID in the Profile of their 2023 Leapfrog Hospital Survey and have submitted the 2023 Leapfrog Hospital Survey.


Hospitals that fail to join Leapfrog's NHSN Group and/or provide a valid NHSN ID in the Profile of their 2023 Leapfrog Hospital Survey and/or submit their 2023 Leapfrog Hospital Survey will be publicly reported as "Declined to Respond" for all five infection measures.


JOINING LEAPFROG'S NHSN GROUP

Note: Both adult and pediatric facilities are required to join Leapfrog's NHSN Group to have data reported for Section 7B: Healthcare-Associated Infections of their Leapfrog Hospital Survey.

- 1. Log into NHSN (needs to be someone with Administrator rights): https://sams.cdc.gov/
- 2. Once logged in, select "NHSN Reporting"



3. Select "Patient Safety" for the component, select your Facility, and then "Submit."



4. Select "Group" and then "Join"




- 5. Enter the following:
 - a. Group ID: 44303
 - b. Group Joining Password: LeapfrogHospitalSurvey
- 6. Select "Join Group" button.
- 7. After agreeing to the message, you will be brought to the "Confer Rights-Patient Safety" screen where you will see the data that Leapfrog is requesting access to (skip to Step 11 on page 7 below).


ACCESSING LEAPFROG'S DATA RIGHTS TEMPLATE IF ALREADY IN LEAPFROG'S NHSN GROUP

Note: Hospitals may also follow the steps below to confirm they have already joined Leapfrog's NHSN Group.

- 8. If you have not done so already, log into NHSN by following Steps 1-3 above.
- 9. Select "Group" and then "Confer Rights"




10. On the "Memberships" page, select "The Leapfrog Group (44303)" from your groups, and click "Confer Rights."



REVIEWING AND COMPLETING LEAPFROG'S DATA RIGHTS TEMPLATE

11. The "Confer Rights - Patient Safety" page will appear as follows:



Note: Leapfrog's Data Rights Template was last updated on April 5, 2017.

12. You will need to review the requested information and select "Accept" at the bottom of the screen to share your data with Leapfrog. Leapfrog requires that all hospitals in Leapfrog's NHSN Group review their Rights Acceptance Report at least annually, before the June 22, 2023 NHSN join-by-date and whenever updates are made to their location mapping in NHSN.

Hospitals must include **any locations that were active during the reporting period** even if they are currently inactive to ensure that Leapfrog obtains an accurate SIR. Additionally, please confirm that you have given Leapfrog access to data from your 2022 NHSN Patient Safety Component - Annual Hospital Survey.

Hospitals should review Leapfrog's Data Rights Template and re-accept annually, even if no updates need to be made for your hospital.

Users will also be prompted to review and accept the Data Rights Template any time Leapfrog makes updates to the data they are requesting access to. Failure to accept these changes means that Leapfrog

will no longer be able to obtain data for your facility and your facility will be reported as "Not Available" for all five infection measures in Section 7B.



a. ● and ☑ indicate that the relevant piece of data is being requested by the Group.

- b. The \(\ldots \) icon indicates areas of the data rights template that have changed (either a new request or the Group has removed the request).
- The Group will specify criteria for plan status, time period, and event or denominator type for events and denominators.
- d. The Data Rights Template will automatically include both inactive and active locations that a facility has mapped. Please leave the template with all locations checked for each applicable HAI type, and only mark items on the template as "N/A" or unselect locations if they do not apply to your facility. Hospitals must include any locations that were active during the reporting period even if they are currently inactive to ensure that Leapfrog obtains the appropriate SIR.

Important Note: Hospitals must also provide an accurate NHSN ID in the Profile of their 2023 Leapfrog Hospital Survey and submit the 2023 Leapfrog Hospital Survey.

NOTE ON MULTI-CAMPUS REPORTING

In alignment with other sections of the Survey, Leapfrog requires that hospitals within a system report individually to the Leapfrog Hospital Survey. This policy also applies to hospitals that share a CMS Certification Number, taxpayer ID, hospital license, etc. that are not within a contiguous geographic location. This policy also requires that hospitals report separately to NHSN. NHSN's policy aligns with Leapfrog's and is stated as follows: "If the facilities are physically separate buildings from each other, whether on the same property or over multiple campuses, then they should be enrolled separately in NHSN. Each facility should have its own, unique NHSN OrgID. When a CCN is shared across multiple facilities, the CDC will aggregate the data from all applicable NHSN OrgIDs and will send to CMS under the single CCN for CMS reporting purposes. Each distinct facility should monitor HAIs and prevention efforts separately, for the purposes of accurate tracking and targeted infection control." ¹

If your facility or system is currently incorrectly enrolled and reporting data from multiple facilities with a single NHSN ID, then you will need to follow these NHSN instructions¹ to address this situation:

- 1. Continue reporting into one NHSN OrgID for the remainder of the current quarter. For example, if you realize in February 2022 that your healthcare system is incorrectly enrolled, continue reporting this way until all data for 2022 quarter 1 (through March 2022) have been entered.
- Once all data for the current quarter have been entered, continue to use the established NHSN OrgID for the reporting of data from the largest hospital in the healthcare system. You will need to enroll each of the additional hospitals as separate facilities in NHSN. The process of enrolling separate facilities may begin

- at any time; however, we recommend that facilities wait to enter data into the "new" NHSN facilities until the start of the next quarter. To enroll facilities, you will need to have "NHSN Enrollment" listed as an activity on your SAMS profile. Email the NHSN Helpdesk (NHSN@cdc.gov) if you need to have "NHSN Enrollment" added to your SAMS profile.
- Once all data for the current quarter have been entered, inactivate all NHSN locations in the established OrgID that represent units in a physically separate facility. For detailed instructions on inactivating a location, please see page 11 from the 2013 NHSN Newsletter: http://www.cdc.gov/nhsn/PDFs/Newsletters/Newsletter-Dec2013.pdf.
- 4. Complete enrollment and facility set-up for the new NHSN facilities, including proper location mapping. If the facility was using CDA to upload data into NHSN, each new NHSN facility will need a separate OID. The OIDs for the new facilities can be requested using this process: http://www.cdc.gov/nhsn/PDFs/CDA/OID Assignment Procedure.pdf. Once the OIDs are obtained, they should be entered into the new NHSN facilities and shared with your vendor.

REGENERATING DATASETS, DOWNLOADING CMS IPPS REPORTS, AND CALCULATING STANDARDIZED INFECTION RATIOS (SIR)

Data is obtained directly from CDC's National Healthcare Safety Network (NHSN). Hospitals should regenerate datasets and download reports directly from NHSN **on the same dates as Leapfrog** for the purposes of verifying your data by following the instructions below.

REGENERATING DATA SETS

Generating datasets is the first step to performing analysis in NHSN. This process will freeze your NHSN data at the current date and time by copying those data into defined datasets.


When you wish to view updates to the data contained in your NHSN reports or to include data entered since the datasets were last generated, you must regenerate datasets for those updates to be reflected. Datasets are user-specific; therefore, each user in NHSN who wishes to analyze data must generate datasets.


- 1. Hospitals should regenerate datasets in NHSN by:
 - Navigating to Analysis > Generate Data Sets




Select "No, leave existing data sets" in the pop-up.



 Do not edit the "Beginning" or "Ending" dates. The beginning date should auto-fill to 01/2020, and the ending date should be left blank. Note that this is not the reporting period; we will select the reporting period when we download the reports.




- Click "Generate Reporting Data Sets" and allow the application to run.
 - While the regeneration is occurring, you can log out or continue to work in other areas of NHSN. When you return to the "Generate Data Sets" screen, you will see a progress bar if still processing, otherwise, you will see a time completed.
- The box on the bottom right confirms when the last successful regeneration occurred.



DOWNLOADING CMS IPPS REPORTS

- 2. After the regeneration is complete, hospitals should then download reports in NHSN by:
 - Navigating to Analysis > Reports > CMS Reports > Acute Care Hospitals (ACHs) or Critical
 Access Hospitals (CAHs) and download the following five reports:
 - CLABSI in ICUs and select wards:
 "SIR ACH CLABSI Data for CMS IPPS (2015 Baseline)"
 - CAUTI in ICUs and select wards:
 "SIR ACH CAUTI Data for CMS IPPS (2015 Baseline)"
 - SSI: Colon:
 "SIR ACH Complex 30-Day SSI Data for CMS IPPS (2015 Baseline)"
 - Facility-wide inpatient MRSA Blood Lab-Identified Events:
 "SIR ACH MRSA Blood FacwideIN LabID Data for CMS IPPS (2015 Baseline)"
 - Facility-wide inpatient C. Diff Lab-Identified Events:
 "SIR ACH CDI FacwideIN LabID Data for CMS IPPS (2015 Baseline)"



Hospitals must use the specific CMS reports noted above for verifying their data since they only include specified locations and in-plan data used by Leapfrog and CMS.

These reports were created to allow facilities to review the infection data that would be submitted to CMS on their behalf for the IQR Program. However, these same output options can be used to verify the data that Leapfrog is obtaining directly from NHSN for your facility. CMS publishes their quarterly deadlines here: https://qualitynet.cms.gov/inpatient/igr/resources (Important Dates & Deadlines).


The CLABSI/CAUTI reports will include in-plan CLABSI or CAUTI data for each adult and pediatric ICU and in-plan CLABSI or CAUTI data for each adult and pediatric medical, surgical, and medical/surgical ward, as well as the SIR for your hospital. The other reports will include in-plan MRSA blood laboratory-identified events data or C. Diff. laboratory-identified events data or SSI: Colon procedure data. Be sure you are using the correct date range when generating your NHSN reports:

Data Download Dates:


- June 23, 2023 summaryYQ 2022Q1 to 2022Q4 (see <u>Instructions</u>)
- August 24, 2023 summaryYQ 2022Q1 to 2022Q4 (see Instructions)
- October 24, 2023 summaryYQ 2022Q3 to 2023Q2 (see <u>Instructions</u>)
- December 21, 2023 summaryYQ 2022Q3 to 2023Q2 (see Instructions)

You will need to modify your NHSN reports to get the appropriate SIR for the reporting period. **To update your NHSN report, follow these instructions before running:**


- 1. Select the report you would like to run and hit "Modify Report."
- 2. Select **PDF** under the "Title/Format" tab.



- 3. Select the "Time Period" tab. Then select **summaryYQ** as the Date Variable and enter the correct Beginning and Ending Quarters.
 - June 23 and August 24 data downloads: 2022Q1 as the Beginning and 2022Q4 as the Ending Quarter.
 - October 24 and December 21 data downloads: 2022Q3 as the Beginning and 2023Q2 as the Ending Quarter.



4. Select the "Display Options" tab and change the value of the dropdown menu from SummaryYQ to **Cumulative** to get a cumulative SIR for the time period specified.



Important Note: Do not make any other modifications to the report options. Other options specified are the default CMS IPPS report options and should be left as is to ensure that you are downloading the correct data.

5. After updating the file format, time period, and the group by options, select "Run".



Reminder: Reports should be downloaded, reviewed, and saved on the <u>same day</u> as Leapfrog to ensure your data matches what Leapfrog has obtained. NHSN data downloaded by Leapfrog will be refreshed on your Hospital Details Page on the dates listed in the "<u>Deadlines and Reporting Periods</u>" table on page 4.

DOWNLOADING THE 2022 PATIENT SAFETY COMPONENT - ANNUAL HOSPITAL SURVEY TO REVIEW RESPONSES


Per NHSN's requirements, the 2022 Patient Safety Component – Annual Hospital Survey must be submitted by March 1, 2023. However, hospitals can update their survey at any time based on the prior calendar year (i.e., 2022). Leapfrog will download updated data and refresh Leapfrog Hospital Survey Results on the dates specified in the "Deadlines and Reporting Periods" table provided on page 4.

Hospitals can view their responses to the 2022 Patient Safety Component – Annual Hospital Survey directly within NHSN by following the instructions below. Please **print and save a copy** of your 2022 NHSN Annual Hospital Survey for your records.

- 1. Log into the Patient Safety Component within NHSN at https://sams.cdc.gov/
- 2. In the left-hand navigation, select "Surveys" then "Find"
- 3. On the "Find Annual Survey" page, select the following:
 - a. Facility ID: <Your Facility Name and NHSN ID>
 - i. This should automatically default to the facility you are logged in as.
 - b. Survey Type: <FACSRV-PS Hospital Survey Data>

- 4. **Print/save** a copy of your 2022 NHSN Annual Hospital Survey.
- 5. A screenshot is provided below for your reference:



The steps listed above can also be used to check your teaching status, which Leapfrog obtains directly from the "Hospital Facility" section of the Patient Safety Component – Annual Hospital Survey. For the purposes of the 2023 Leapfrog Hospital Survey, Leapfrog will consider the following types a "teaching hospital": Major and Graduate.

A survey will not display if your facility has not yet completed the 2022 Patient Safety Component – Annual Hospital Survey, which was due on March 1, 2023. Facilities that did not complete a 2022 Patient Safety Component – Annual Hospital Survey by the data download dates will be scored and publicly reported as "Declined to Respond".

Reminder: Copies of your hospital's 2022 Patient Safety Component- Annual Hospital Survey should be reviewed/saved on the <u>same day</u> as Leapfrog to ensure your data matches what Leapfrog has obtained. NHSN data downloaded by Leapfrog will be refreshed on your Hospital Details Page on the dates listed in the "<u>Deadlines and Reporting Periods</u>" table on page 4.
