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About this Report

Leapfrog's Custom Benchmarking Report is designed to help you summarize and benchmark your hospital's performance on up to 45 measures of patient safety and quality nationally, state-wide, and against other hospitals with similar characteristics, such as bed size, teaching status, type, etc.

Your hospital's performance can be compared by:

- **Value Score:** 0-100 score that summarizes performance across all measures (Indicates how your hospital is doing overall)

- **Measure Scores:** 0-100 score that indicates performance at the individual measure level (Indicates how your hospital is doing on medication reconciliation, cesarean births, etc.)

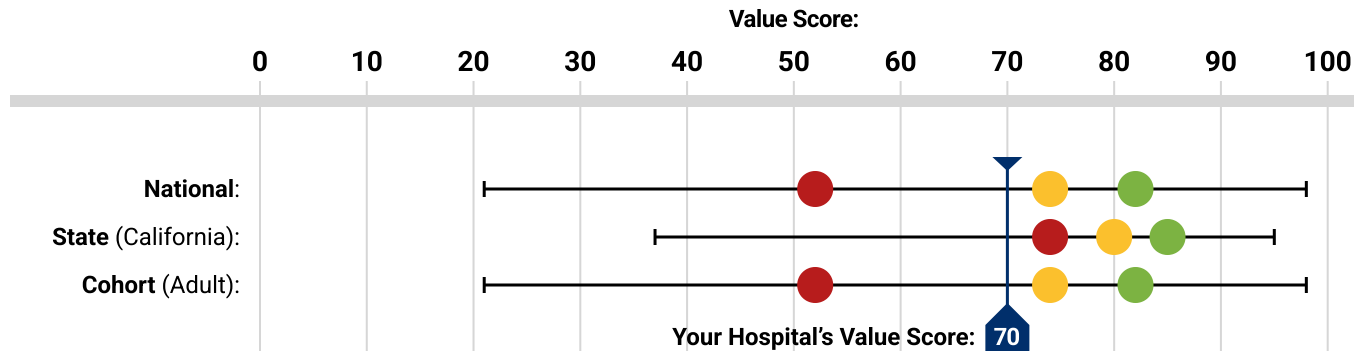
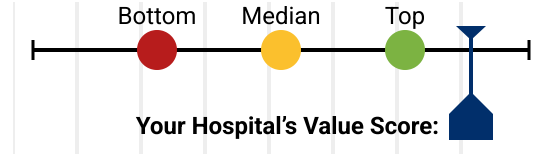
Your Hospital's Value Score

- **Worse than** the Top Quartile of hospitals in your Cohort

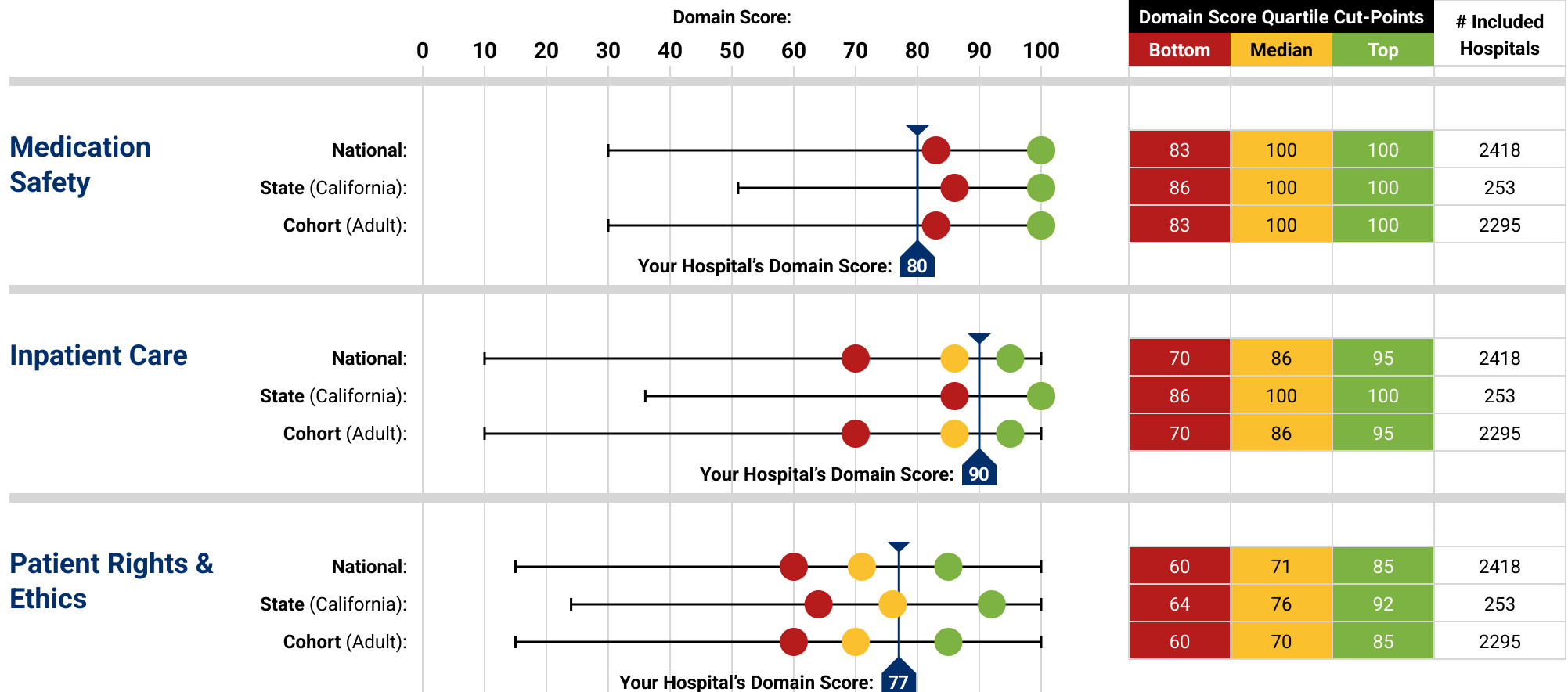
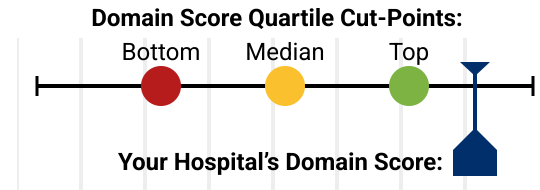

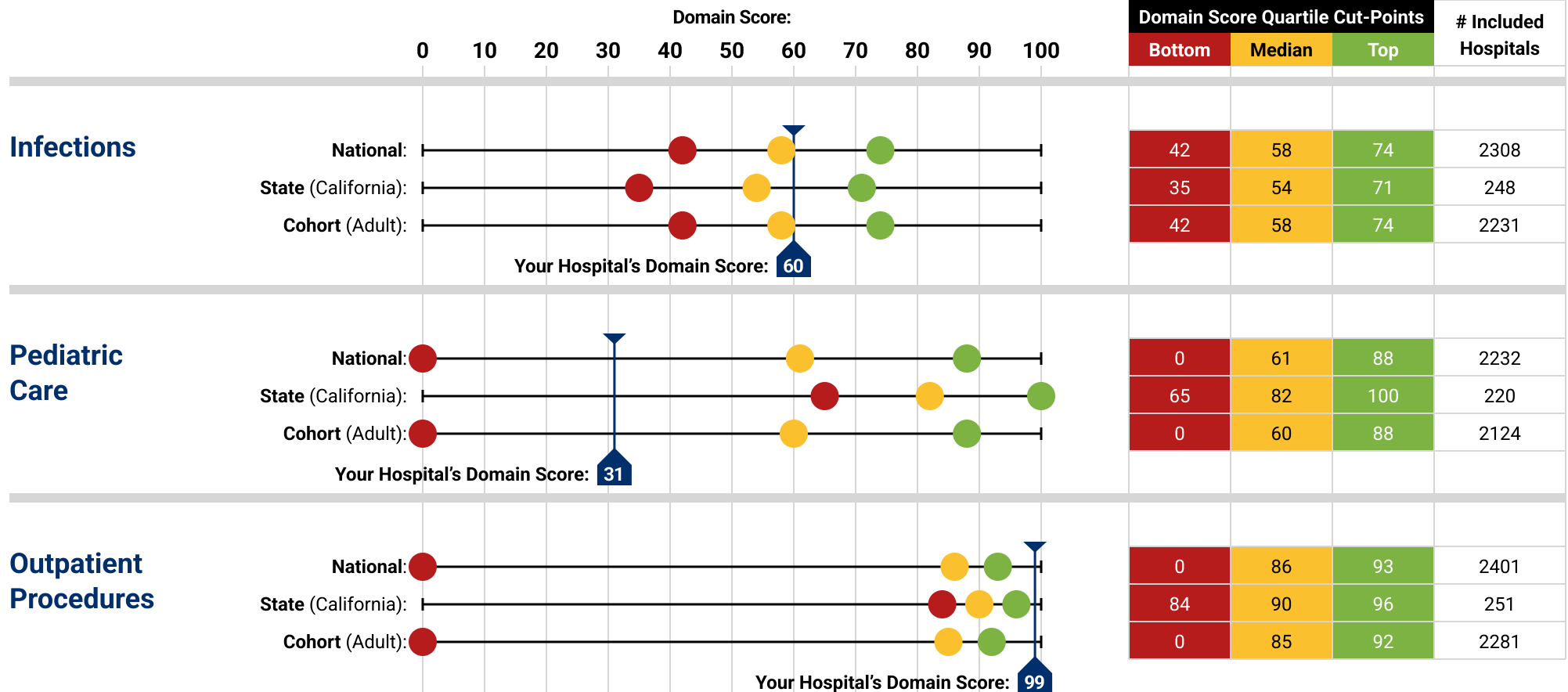
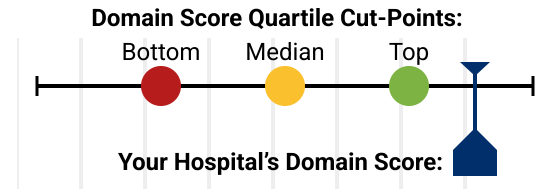
Domain Scores

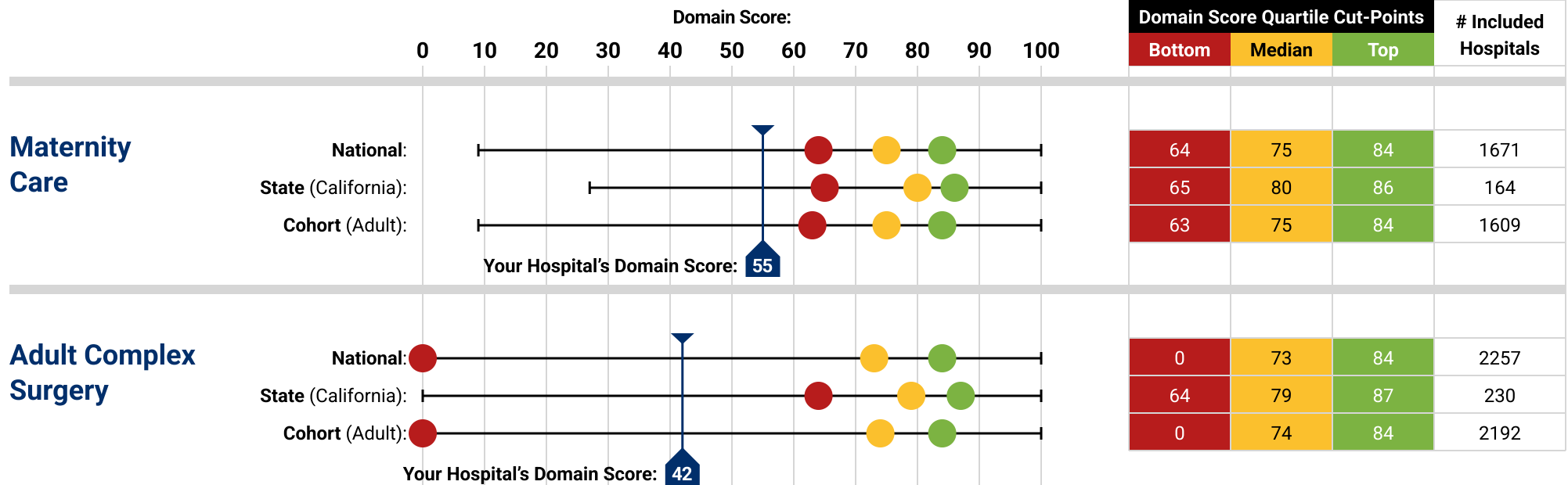
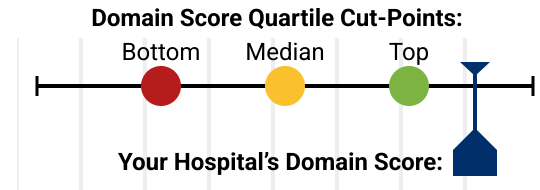

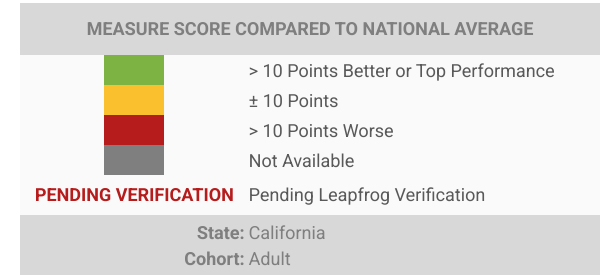
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Measure Scores

Each measure on the Leapfrog Hospital Survey is scored according to the Leapfrog VBP Program™ methodology. The measures within each domain are weighted based on the following criteria: **Volume** (number of patients impacted by the measure), **Harm** (severity of harm being measured or resulting from hospitals not adhering to the clinical guidelines being measured), and **Resource Use** (avoidance of costs related to the measure). 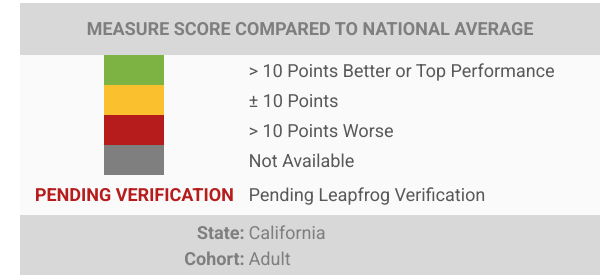

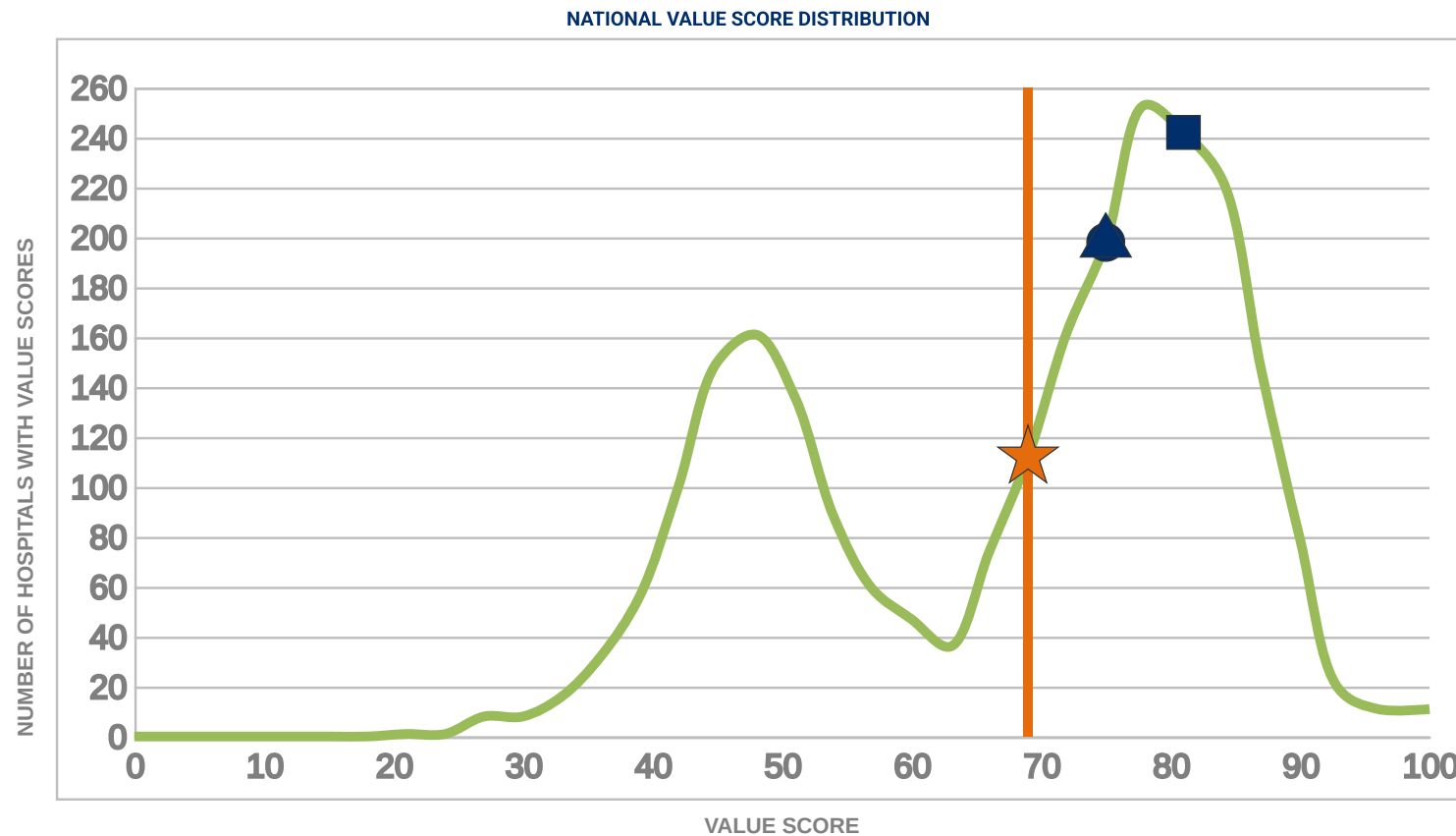
